

Prof. Dr. Robert Hatala, PhD, FESC, FACC



is from the National Institute of Cardiovascular Diseases in Bratislava. He is head of the Department of Cardiology and Angiology where he founded the cardiac arrhythmia program.

He is professor of internal medicine - cardiology at the Medical Faculty of Comenius University in Bratislava and he also teaches at the Slovak Medical University in Bratislava.

Prof. Hatala is working for many years in clinical cardiac electrophysiology with a specific research interest in interventional therapy of arrhythmias, electrical activation of the heart under normal and pathological conditions such as heart failure and sudden cardiac death. He has extensive international experience in all aspects of cardiac mapping, both invasive and noninvasive. From 1990 to 1995, he worked at several cardiology departments in Canada and Western Europe.

Prof. Hatala is the author / co-author of more than 200 scientific contributions including papers in key international journals and presentations at major cardiological congresses, he is a co-author of several guidelines of the European Society of Cardiology. He lectured on all continents in several languages. He served as elected president of the Slovak Society of Cardiology, he is fellow of the European Society of Cardiology and the American College of Cardiology, he is an honorary member of several national societies of cardiology. Since 2020 he serves as executive editor of the European Heart Journal, the top ranked journal in cardiovascular medicine.
